- Counseling with clients

- Transportation for clients for reasonable needs
- Investigative birthmother work. Investigate possible birthfather(s)

- Advocate on behalf of birthmother with other services providers
- Assist client with adoption planning surrounding client's desires
- Visit, educate and stay connected with pregnancy resource centers, health departments, and social workers. Building relationships with hospitals, churches, and schools. Attend events that support or encourage adoption and our pro-life ministry.

- Bachelor's Degree required, preferably in Social Work, but other Human Service field will be considered.

- Must be able to sign CCS' Statement of Faith & Pro-Life Position
